

Activate Pseudonymisation

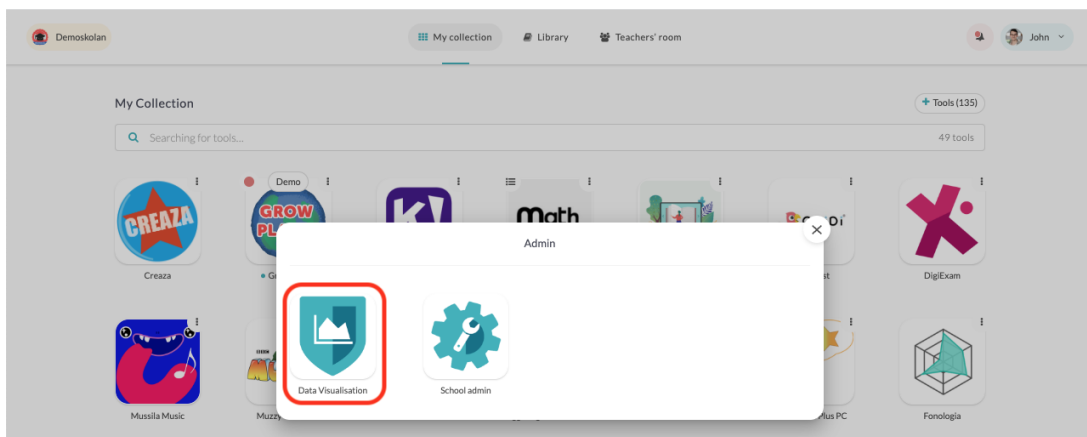

When you choose to pseudonymise the data sent to the provider, as below, Skolons pseudonymisation module creates fictitious names and e-mail addresses for students and teachers, as well as fictitious names of classes and groups. Teachers can see which pseudonyms have been created for the students in the **Teachers' room**.

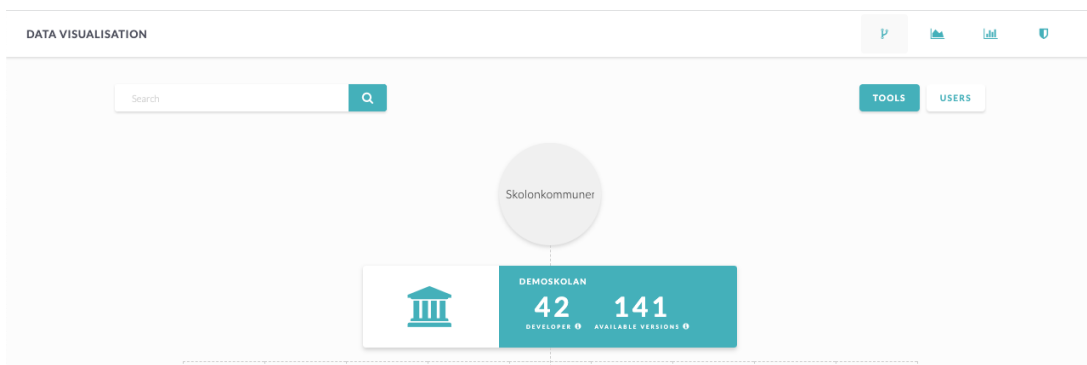
When teachers open a tool from a provider that receives pseudonymised data, they see their pseudonym inside the tool.

To enable pseudonymisation of user data to a provider, proceed as follows:

1. Open Skolon Data Visualisation.



2. Click the **Data Protection** icon in the upper right corner.



3. Search for and click on the provider to which you want to pseudonymise user data.
