## Configure Windows devices to use Skolon Pass

In this article you'll learn the steps to configure your inTune enrolled Windows devices to use Skolon Pass (QR-codes) as a sign-in method.

Before proceeding with the configuration, make sure you have followed the steps described in the article <u>Install Skolon as an external Identity Provider (IDP) to Entra</u>

## **Prerequisites**

Microsoft only supports the use of an external IdP for the following Windows devices:

- Windows 11 Pro Education/SE or
- Windows 11 Education licences.

To be able to use federated sign-in, users must have some of the following licences in Entra:

- Windows Pro Education/SE,
- Windows Education A3,
- Windows Education A5

To configure Skolon as an IdP for Entra ID, the following prerequisites must be met in Entra:

- InTune Admin access for administrators to configure and manage devices.
- Intune licences for all users who will use federated logins (Auto-enrollment requires Microsoft Intune Plan 1; licence type depends on your needs).

## Configuration in Intune Admin Center

To configure inTune enrolled devices to use a federated login, follow the instructions as described in Microsofts support article "Configure federated sign-in for Windows devices".

Use the following settings when configuring the devices:
